Other: Local Assistance and Tribal Consistency Fund

The Local Assistance and Tribal Consistency Fund delivers \$2 billion to eligible Tribal governments and eligible revenue-sharing counties as a general revenue enhancement program.

The American Rescue Plan appropriates \$750 million to allocate and pay to eligible revenue-sharing counties for fiscal years 2022 and 2023 (\$1.5 billion total).

 Recipients have broad discretion on the use of funds. Expressly, the statute permits recipients to use funds for any governmental purpose other than lobbying.
