# SPECIAL MEETING TUESDAY, MAY 6, 2014 ACTION MINUTES

The Board of Supervisors of San Benito County met in the Board Chambers on the above date in *regular session*. Supervisors Muenzer, De La Cruz, Rivas, Botelho and Barrios were present. Also present was County Administrative Officer Ray Espinosa, County Counsel Matt Granger and Clerk of the Board Denise Thome. Chairman Muenzer presided.

#### 8:30 a.m. CALL TO ORDER:

#### **CLOSED SESSION:**

Stephen Rosati spoke under public comment before the closed session. He felt there was a Brown Act violation.

County Counsel Granger reported that by a 4-1 vote with Supervisor De La Cruz voting no, they decided to proceed forward with agenda item #28 on that day's regular meeting agenda and avail itself of the cure and correct provisions found in government code section 54960.1(c)(2). (The motion passed 4-1 with Supervisor De La Cruz voting no.)
