Staff Recommendations:

- 1. Authorize and direct the County Administrative Officer to prepare the FY20/21 Adopted Budget Resolution reflecting changes made by the Board during budget hearings including supplemental budget amendments proposed by staff, the administrative corrections above, and the fixed asset and position schedule adjustments.
- 2. Authorize and direct the County Administrative Officer, in conjunction with the County Auditor-Controller, to develop the adopted budget document in accordance with the County Budget Act.
- 3. Authorize and direct the County Administrative Officer to make adjustments to position counts, appropriations, revenues, fund balances etc. to correct clerical errors as needed.
- 4. Authorize the County Administrative Officer, if any unbudgeted/unassigned fund balance is available at year-end FY19/20, to allocate the funds in the following order:
 - Reestablish the disaster recovery reserve in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000.
 - Available General Fund Reserves
- 5. Direct staff to satisfy meet and confer obligations, if any, regarding reduced position allocations.
- 6. Conclude FY20/21 budget hearings.
