Amendments:

- Attachment A—Increase to the Agricultural Commissioner Budget Unit (1250) in the amount of \$32,000 for the purchase of a pickup truck. This item is a rollover that was previously budgeted and approved by the Board of Supervisors in FY2019-20. Due to COVID-19 the County did not receive the vehicle until FY2020-21, thus the request for an amendment to the CAO Recommended Budget.
- Attachment B—Reduction to the Child Support Services Budget Unit (2530) in the amount of \$169,580. Reduction is related to a decrease of 2.0 Full Time Equivalent (FTE's) Staffing levels due to reduced revenue allocations from the State Department of Child Support Services.
- Attachment C—Increase to the General Fund Contingencies Budget Unit (1325) in the amount of \$500,000.
- Attachment D—Increase to the Non-Department Expenditures Budget Unit (1015) in the amount of \$100,000 to cover the costs of a consultant to manage the Parks Master Plan. A transfer in/out from the Parks Impact Fee Fund to the General Fund to cover the consultant costs.
