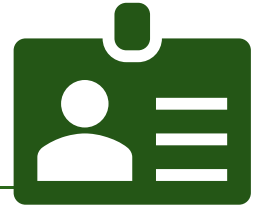

DOCUMENTS



Birth Certificate

With your birth certificate, you can get a California ID or Driver's License and with BOTH, you can get your Social Security Card. The state you were born in has control over your birth records, and they maintain the master records and can reproduce authorized, certified (stamped with state seal) copies for a processing fee. Normally, requests for birth certificate copies are handled through the mail. Check with your local state government office for instructions and notice of fees. By doing it yourself, you will save the money that 3rd party birth certificate companies charge for performing this service. It might take you 30 minutes to do, but it will save you \$15-\$50 from paying additional fees.

Note: Often times your probation officer has copies of vital documents that can be provided to you.

ID/Driver's license

Items needed for your Identification Card or Driver's License

Driver's License or Identification Card Application form is located at the DMV. To obtain this form by mail, call DMV's automated phone service 24 hours a day, 7 days a week at 1(800) 777 - 0133.

Only the original or a certified copy of one of the following documents is acceptable:

- US Birth Certificate or US Certificate or Report of Birth Abroad
- Federal Proof of Indian Blood Degree, INS American Indian Card
- US Passport
- US Military Identification Cards
- Certificate of Naturalization or Citizenship
- Permanent Resident Card
- Certification from California Department of Corrections or DJJ
- Valid I-94 stamped "Refugee," "Parole or Parolee," "Asylee," or Sec 207, Sec 208, Sec 209, Sec 212d (2), HP or PIP

Note: If your license was suspended due to child support, you are able to request the denial be reviewed with the FL 670 form ("DL Review Suspension" listed above)

(You can also use this system to change your address or request a replacement Medicare card.) If you are deaf or hard of hearing, call the TTY number: 1(800) 325 - 0778.

To get your Social Security Card, go to your local office with the following documents:
Proof of citizenship

If you are an U.S. citizen, Social Security must see your:

- U.S. birth certificate
- U.S. driver's license, State-issued non-driver identity card or U.S. passport.

If you are not a U.S. citizen, Social Security must see your current U.S. immigration documents. Acceptable documents from the Department of Homeland Security include:

- Form I-551 (includes machine-readable immigrant visa with your unexpired foreign passport);
- I-94 with your unexpired foreign passport; or Work permit card (I-766 or I-688B).

Application (included in packet)

- Contact Probation Department for juvenile expungement application
- NOTE: The judge does not like to review records until the applicant has been off probation for a year.
- Sealing a juvenile record does not affect the ability of insurance companies to access your records through the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) in Sacramento, nor will it prevent the Federal Government, including branches of the military service, from accessing your sealed records
- All juvenile records must be reported even though sealed when applying for a security clearance or employment with a private company that engages in business with the Federal Government.
- If you have been denied "without prejudice" you may resubmit your application once you have resolved the issues blocking the seal on your record, such as paying restitution or waiting a longer period of time to show rehabilitation.

PBV FAQ

The Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) program, also known as “**Section 8**”, provides rental assistance to low income individuals or families.

There are two main Section 8 Voucher programs: one for Santa Cruz County and one for City of Hollister (which also includes the City of San Juan Bautista).

Once a family receives a voucher, the family finds its own rentals from homes and apartments on the private market. The family pays about a third of its income in rent to the landlord, and the Housing Authority pays the rest, up to a certain limit, directly to the landlord. The family and landlord sign a rental agreement or lease provided by the landlord. The family pays the security deposit required by the landlord.

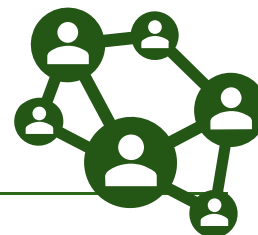
