Staff Recommendations:

1. Adopt a resolution 2021-68 approving the Fiscal Year (FY) 2021-2022 Recommended Budget as spending authority until the adoption of the FY 2021-2022 Adopted Budget.
2. Authorize and direct the County Administrative Officer to prepare the FY21/22 Adopted Budget Resolution reflecting changes made by the Board during budget hearings including supplemental budget amendments proposed by staff, the administrative corrections above, and the fixed asset and position schedule adjustments.
3. Authorize and direct the County Administrative Officer, in conjunction with the County Auditor-Controller, to develop the adopted budget document in accordance with the County Budget Act.
4. Authorize and direct the County Administrative Officer to make adjustments to position counts, appropriations, revenues, fund balances etc. to correct clerical errors as needed.
5. Authorize the County Administrative Officer, if any unbudgeted/unassigned fund balance is available at year-end FY20/21, to allocate the funds in the following order:
 - Reestablish the disaster recovery reserve in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.
 - Available General Fund Reserves
6. Conclude FY21/22 budget hearings.
