Supervisor Bob Tiffany gave a bit of background on the MOU, and how the thought process was to get the MOU more focused and get the deliverables narrowed down to County and EDC expectations.

Dulce Alonso, Senior Administration Analyst, provided further details on what changes have been implemented within Amendment #1.

Supervisor Peter Hernandez would like a better sense on the projects that are being worked on. Would like to make the amendment clean and specific goal oriented. Would like an update on where we are currently at with projects & amendment

Rene Wells from Economic Development Cooperation provided a quick overview of the matrix's and what was implement into the amendment.

County Administration Officer, Ray Espinosa, mentioned that EDC would work as a one stop shop for the community and those coming into the community with developments. Streamline the process.

9. DISCUSS proposed Sales Tax Reimbursement program and provide direction.

Supervisor Tiffany provided some background information, goal of the program was to analyze what the County could do to provide incentives and generate revenue.

Marc Fontes, EDC, provided a presentation & summary of the program. The basic concept is of this program is to encourage new and existing businesses that generate sales tax revenue to locate or expand in San Benito County.

Eligible reimbursement costs for improvement and impact fees

Marc: The committee also discussed a second-tier program for businesses generating \$10K and still stacking revenue can apply for the program specifically health and safety improvements

Restaurant specific issues to environmental health and ADA compliance would fall under the Public Health and Safety improvements.

Supervisor Tiffany: What is the argument for lowering the threshold?

Marc: Make the program more inclusive

Supervisor Hernandez: more enticing to businesses.

\$1 million revenue would be required for \$10,000

A specific agreement with each business on how the sales tax reimbursement would work out

Supervisor Tiffany suggested to taking this program to the board for further dialogue and consideration. Would like more data on setting the level of eligible reimbursement costs \$10K or lower.

Supervisor Hernandez in agreement with taking this item to the board.

Marc: more details from legal standpoint
