The San Benito County Office of Emergency Services invites you to attend a review of the 2022 San Benito County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazardous Mitigation Plan before it is finalized and submitted to the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (CalOES) and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for approval.

The County, Cities of Hollister and San Juan Bautista, San Benito County Water District, and Sunnyslope County Water District have worked together over the past year to create a comprehensive Hazardous Mitigation Plan. Hazardous mitigation describes the actions taken to lessen the impact of disasters on people, property, economies, and the environment. Hazard mitigation plans provide the communities the opportunity to think deliberately about the greatest vulnerabilities in the community and existing capacity to mitigate disaster impacts, and then plan to address identified issues through incremental, achievable projects.
