Re: Proposal for Anger Management Intervention Classes in the San Benito County Jail

Summary/Background

With the goal to stop generational violence in the San Benito County Community, Transcend Educational Services (TES) has been providing evidenced-based certified domestic violence, parenting and anger management prevention and intervention classes since 2015. From July 2017 - March 2022, each year TES has an average of 79 SBC Court mandated participants, both male and female, English, and Spanish speakers, referred, enrolled, and participating in Intervention classes outside of incarceration. TES has a 96% rate of successful completion and evidence of participant's positive cognitive and behavioral changes. TES is currently contracted by San Benito County Probation and the Workforce Development, through the Prison to Employment Grant. TES has provided anger management intervention to forty-four (44) inmates in custody at the San Benito County Jail in the past year, from March 2021-Current. TES is conducting the following and is requesting to continue to do so through AB109 funding.

- 1) Conduct a 26-week Anger Management Group three times per week, once a week for each group. Each group shall be conducted for a duration of one and a half (1.5) hours. Group attendance required to justify the maintaining of a Group scheduling shall consist of group attendance of not less than two (2) attendees and no more than twelve (12).
- 2) Attendees of the group are expected to be in attendance for the full duration of the group session and must attend 90% of the program, or not miss more than 1 class to avoid termination. The contractor is expected in general to not make exceptions to the tenants of any group members for less than the duration of the full group activity.
- 3) Anger Management groups are open-ended and continuous. Upon release, defendants can transfer class credit incurred while incarcerated by continuing the Anger Management program through Transcend Educational Services, according to TES, probation, and court's conditions assigned to the participant.
- 4) The contractor is expected to maintain all required documentation as per the requirements for standard protocol for Anger Management Intervention. Individual



progress reports will be completed after attendees reach 13 and 26 classes or as requested by San Benito County Probation and/or the San Benito County Superior Court.

Draft Proposal: Jail Garden Build & Gardening Program

Background:

Growing Hearts Garden Center is a 501(c)3 Nonprofit organization founded in 2018 serving special needs adults and simultaneously beautifying community spaces in San Benito County. At Growing Hearts, we provide a safe and supportive environment for our special friends so that they may challenge themselves and gain further independence through our project-based learning and job coaching.

Growing Hearts has experience building and maintaining gardens. We are interested in working with the County of San Benito to build a garden at the San Benito County Jail and facilitate a gardening program within the jail. We will provide support and education in the garden for inmates that participate in the Gardening Program. For this program we intend to teach inmates effective gardening practices and ensure a solid background in plant care, giving them the tools necessary to obtain and retain employment upon release.

Our job coaches, special needs staff, and volunteers will assist with construction, maintenance, gardening courses, and promotion of the garden. The majority of gardening courses will be taught by the founders of Growing Hearts and some may be taught by guest instructors from local organizations.

Scope:

Growing Hearts, with the assistance of Cutting Edge Landscape, will construct garden beds at the San Benito County Jail. We will work with inmates on construction tasks such as preparing materials and conducting finishing touches.

After construction of the garden is complete, each week we will hold a gardening course lasting 1 hour with 1 hour of instructor access after class in the garden where we teach inmates different ways to be self-sufficient, resourceful gardeners. Some techniques we will share include how to support young plants, protect those plants from the cold, house and nurture cuttings, rid the garden of weeds, collect seeds, keep wild mammals away, create weed barriers, and manage garden pests. We will cover important environmental topics such as composting, healthy soils, and waste reduction practices in the garden. We will discuss proper care for a variety of plants that attendees can grow. We will assist them in growing a successful garden to ensure access to enough organic foods to meet dietary needs for a productive and healthy life as well as to gain the skills they need to care for plants in a nursery/landscaping setting. Classroom settings for the program will include circle processes that have proven effective with other garden programs with incarcerated populations.

Budget:

We have made significant connections in the community to obtain gardening material donations and free delivery of materials. This greatly reduces our operating costs for this proposal. However, we are also happy to provide service to the County in obtaining grants and donations that could help us provide even better services at this garden.

It would help the team at Growing Hearts if the County were to make a donation to fund the gardening activities supplied by our staff. To complete the garden build and a garden program that lasts one year we request the amount of \$24,618. The garden program may be supported by grants in future years.

2022 Garden Maintenance Timeline:

January: Protect & maintain garden, plan for spring

February: Prep garden, plant bare root perennials, start cool-season seeds indoors **March:** Set out seed starts, plant spring garden, watch for frosts, add compost

April: Pull weeds, add mulch, sow greens every week

May: Plant for summer, harvest cool-season crops, manage insects June: Manage weeds, direct sow, thin seedlings, add compost July: Cultivate & amend soil, water soil in early morning, direct sow

August: Evaluate garden successes & failures, plant fall garden, monitor moisture September: Prep garden, plant cool-season vegetables, compost summer annuals October: Compost garden debris, protect seedlings, add mulch, plant weekly

November: Maintain & feed garden, prep for spring

December: Protect & maintain garden



Re: TRUNARC™ HANDHELD NARCOTICS ANALYZER

Summary/Background

BACKGROUND

San Benito County has had a spike in drug overdoses likely linked to fentanyl heavily saturating the local drug supply by lacing drugs like methamphetamine and creating counterfelt pills. In 2021 there were 40 reported administrations of naloxone to individuals experiencing an overdose compared to 38 in 2020 and 23 in 2019. The majority of cases in 2021 occurred in the last three months—many were fentanyl-related.

The spike and pattern in San Benito County follows similar patterns seen across California and in our neighboring counties of Monterey and Santa Cruz. The most recent San Benito County Coroner death data shows seven overdose-related deaths in 2019, nine deaths in 2020 and six thus far in 2021, with the expectation for this number to increase pending final toxicology reports. Three of the deaths from 2021 involved fentanyl. The Santa Clara County Medical Examiner has confirmed at least one San Benito County overdose death was due to a new fentanyl analog. The new fentanyl analog has been found in other counties (Santa Cruz and Santa Clara) and may be contributing to the increase in overdoses.

ISSUE

The impact of more potent narcotics within the local drug supply, elevates the critical need for local quick and accurate identification of substances. Currently, local testing capabilities are very limited. Sending drug samples away for testing creates long turn-around times for results and is costly. In addition, there is no way for personnel across agencies to assess level of risk exposure in real-time or determine types of drugs/trends circulating in San Benito County.

BENEFITS

TruNarc™ is a field-based handheld Raman analyzer that tests for narcotics, precursors, and cutting agents. The device can immediately detect and identify the substance. It is safe to use, as it does not require touching the substance.

It is currently being utilized in Monterey County, secured through a grant proposal from PrescribeSafe Monterey to Montage Health and is housed at Community Hospital of Monterey County's Emergency Department, where law enforcement partners and other authorized personnel are allowed to access the

device 24/7. They have had at least 5 different law enforcement agencies utilize TruNarc™ and have a designated point person at each law enforcement agency trained on testing procedures. The pharmacists are responsible for safe destruction of contraband brought in by patients and test it prior to destruction. They have also been able to identify a novel fentanyl being sold in the area as an opiate or methamphetamine, called U-47700 or commonly known as pink/pinky/pink stuff. This immediate identification has allowed Prescribe Safe Monterey to create alerts and notify all local partners.

This device enables personnel to scan and identify more than 498 suspected controlled substances in a single, definitive test. The library is automatically updated for emerging substances. It can analyze numerous fentanyl compounds including common analogs, pharmaceutical variants, and 2 precursors NPP, and ANPP.

TruNarc™ is capable of scanning through plastic or glass to minimize contamination, tampering, and increase personnel safety. Additionally, it provides automated, tamper-proof records with scan results, including time-date-location stamps.

Cost of the device includes e-learning software and a limited in-person training of up to 12 individuals.

Having the capability to test drugs locally without additional lab costs and long turnaround times, can provide many benefits. Real-time testing can inform law enforcement of what is circulating locally, provide OES/EMS with information for responding to overdoses, can inform and steer outreach work for the San Benito County Opioid Task Force, can inform Hazel Hawkins Memorial Hospital ER for responding to overdoses, and can be utilized by the court system for testing substances.

IF LEFT UNFUNDED

Santa Clara County Medical Examiners informed the San Benito County Sheriff Coroner of a new novel fentanyl analog for our area — parafluorofentanyl - which is associated with higher potency; however, this is at a delayed rate. Toxicology is typically months postmortem. We anticipate continuing increases in overdoses and obtaining this device with help to identify new substances in our drug supply in a timely fashion. This can then be used to deploy educational outreach and overdose prevention measures. Without TruNarc™ we anticipate that our efforts to reduce the rate of drug overdose and drug overdoses deaths will be less effective, and we will see a continued rise in overdoses and deaths.

TO: Community Corrections Executive Committee:

DOJ is no longer a partner in UNET and the task force needs more support from law enforcement agencies. In addition to UNET The Specialized Intelligence Unit has been formed to assist in protecting our community. Previously, CCP had voted to fund a DDA I position to give legal advice to SIU, at a cost of \$153,034. The position has not been filled and the need for such is limited. The San Benito County District Attorney's Office is asking that the position be an investigator position instead: (2) ¼ time DAIs. The 1/2 time positions would allow for the DAIs to be partners and still meet the needs of investigations within the criminal division of the office. The total amount requested for this change is \$220,125.50, an increase of \$67,091.50. The investigators would assist both UNET and SRU as needed.

Summary/Background

The PassPoint.net system for substance abuse screening service is an ocular scan and passive breath test with instantaneous results, intended to compliment traditional urinalysis or saliva testing. When used as a pre-screen, the system reduces the overall amount of staff time allocated to administering urinalysis or saliva test. It also reduces the cost of testing materials.

The two-year contract expired on January 31, 2022. The Probation Department decided to negotiate the rate and was able to reduce the monthly price to \$550.00 for a duration of two years with the condition the amount will be paid in full in the first year, totaling \$13,200,00.

Funding Request

The Probation Department is requesting carry-over CCP allocation in the amount of \$13,200.00, for the two year use of the Pupilometer/PassPoint.net system for substance abuse screening.
