9. Rural County Representatives of California (RCRC) Update Broadband Strategic Plan grant update, presented by Barbara Hayes

Barbara Hayes, Chief Economic Development Officer at RCRC provided a brief background of the Broadband Strategic Plan grant, which was submitted to the US Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration (EDA) back in December of 2021. RCRC did receive conditional approval of the grant in March of 2022. The grant included a request for Broadband funds for 27 counties, one of which is the County of San Benito. Further information was provided, including a tentative timetable to start the process for a strategic broadband plan.

Supervisor Tiffany asked for clarification on moving forward with other potential projects while the county awaits the Strategic Broadband Plan to be completed.

Barbara provided some clarifications and explained that there is some flexibility in meeting the needs of other potential projects the County may wish to explore and pursue.

Public comment opened.

Kristina Wyatt, San Benito County Business Council, inquired about consultants working with local organizations.

Barbara provided an overview of how the county may move forward in collaboration with a consultant if desired by the organizations involved.

Wayne Norton provided a comment.

The public comment period closed.

10. California Consulting update of Broadband grants applied for, presented by David Marquez.

David Marquez, the Senior Project Planner for California Consulting, provided a brief overview of California Consulting. Expressed that they will be an additional asset to seeking grants concerning broadband and look

forward to collaborating on the current grants that have been sought out by other parties. Will be working with County staff as well to pursue other avenues of funds as well.

David will follow up with Barbara Hayes, from RCRC, to further discuss broadband grants.

11. Hankins Technology, update on CLEC status, Auction 904, and any additional funding Broadband related projects within San Benito County, presented by James Hankins.

James provided an update. Did receive the Competitive Local Exchange Carrier funding from CPC, now working on permits and drawings to get into the county. Working in collaboration with RMA for obtaining permits. Working to get fiber to homes and businesses and offer services to the areas covered such as San Juan Bautista and locating a location northeast of Hollister.

James Hankins provided further clarifications and comments in response to public comments.

Supervisor Dirks inquired about the average usage an average home typically takes.

James expressed that the average home is typically satisfied with 25 megabits per second, however, one gigabyte will be available for businesses if they desire.

12. Etheric Networks, update, presented by Andrew Brickweg.

Supervisor Tiffany opened the item.

Andrew Brickweg provided an update on the San Juan Bautista Project including a new data center, the water tank installation in the final stages of construction, information on a public hotspot, and the services Etheric networks provide. Etheric is still awaiting California Public Utilities Commission approval on ETC/CPCN application. Once the application for ETC/CPCN is approved, Regional Digital Opportunity Funding (RDOF) is expected to be approved by Federal Communications Commission (FCC) soon after. California Advance Service Funds is also expected to be approved following the RDOF.

Supervisor Tiffany had a few questions consisting of how someone can apply for some of the programs offered. Will south county be covered and how it is being planned?

Andrew provided resources and information on how someone can apply for the programs offered and the anticipated course of action.
